ADDITIONAL OPTION for mobile broadband at no cost

SUPPORT FOR HOUSEHOLDS With Home Access 3.0

Eligible low-income households can apply to receive 2 years of subsidised internet access. Households without school-going children have the option to own a smartphone or tablet.
