#### **Arrival and dismissal arrangements**

The opening hours of the gates will be as follows:

A, C, D	6.30 a.m. to 7.30 a.m. 8 a.m. to 8.45 a.m. 10.30 a.m. to 11.15 a.m.
B (Car drop-off and pick-up)	6.15 a.m. to 8.45 a.m. 11.15 a.m. to 12.15 p.m. (For pick-up of all levels)

As the dismissal will be at the same time for all students, Gate B (for cars) will likely to be opened only from 11.15 a.m. onwards. This is to allow school buses to leave the bus bay first. Parents/guardians are advised to park their cars at nearby car parks so that they can pick up their children/wards earlier from 10.30 a.m. onwards at Gates A, C or D. For car pick-up, we seek your cooperation to display your child/ward's name and class on the car windscreen to expedite the process.
